



Equipment & Tool Safety Acknowledgement

Maintaining a safe environment and an educational process conducive to learning is essential. The expectation is that students adhere to Morris County Vocational School District's Code of Conduct.

All Morris County Vocational School District (MCVSD) courses have been approved by the MCVSD Board of Education and by the NJ Department of Education. Inherent in our vocational programs is an emphasis on the safe use of equipment and tools. Students are required to demonstrate understanding of proper equipment and tool use and shop safety prior to handling any equipment and/or tools. Students must assume responsibility for following safe equipment and tool use practices in the classroom, on school grounds, and on the school bus.

For tools being transported to and from MCVSD, written request by the student and written approval from the instructor is required. Tools must be transported in a tool carrier only, NOT in the pocket of clothing, purse, backpack, etc. Items that are deemed a safety hazard are not permitted in school and may result in disciplinary action and confiscation. The school is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
